The boys in charge of the trucks were bronzed & business like and showed already the effects of the trip, though all were alert and gave no indication of being tired of their job

A most enjoyable feature of the trip ~~was~~ for the boys was the chicken dinner given Sunday by H. E. Fivestone of Akron at the Fivestone homestead east of town.
